In pursuance of the above resolution, it is notified for the information of all concerned that the amendments in modalities of the existing statute of the Entrance Examination for admission to L.L.M Course be read as under:-

The merit of the candidate shall be calculated on the basis of 60% weightage to the entrance test and 40% weightage to the academic merit of the Candidate in the qualifying degree.</p>	<p>shall have to attempt five questions out of the given eight questions. Each question shall carry 10 marks and the candidates shall answer every question in about 300 words.</p> <p>ii. In II part there shall be 50 multiple choice objective type questions (with four alternative responses), minimum seven questions from each subject mentioned in the syllabus. Each question shall carry one mark and candidate shall attempt all the 50 questions of this component.</p> <p>4. The entrance test shall be qualified with 50% marks (in aggregate).</p> <p>5. The merit of the candidates for admission shall be calculated on the basis of 50% weightage to the entrance test and 50% weightage to the academic merit of the candidate in the qualifying degree.</p>
