The origin of the reptiles lies about 310-320 million agø. the steaming swamps of vears late Carboniferous period, when the first reptiles evolved from advanced reptiliomorphs. A series of footprints from of Nova Scotia dated the fossil strata to 315 Ma show typical reptilian toes and imprints of scales. These tracks are attributed to Hylonoumus, the oldest unquestionable reptile known. It was a small, lizard-like animal, about 20 to 30 centimetres (7.9 to 11.8 in) long, with numerous sharp teeth indicating an insectivorous diet.
