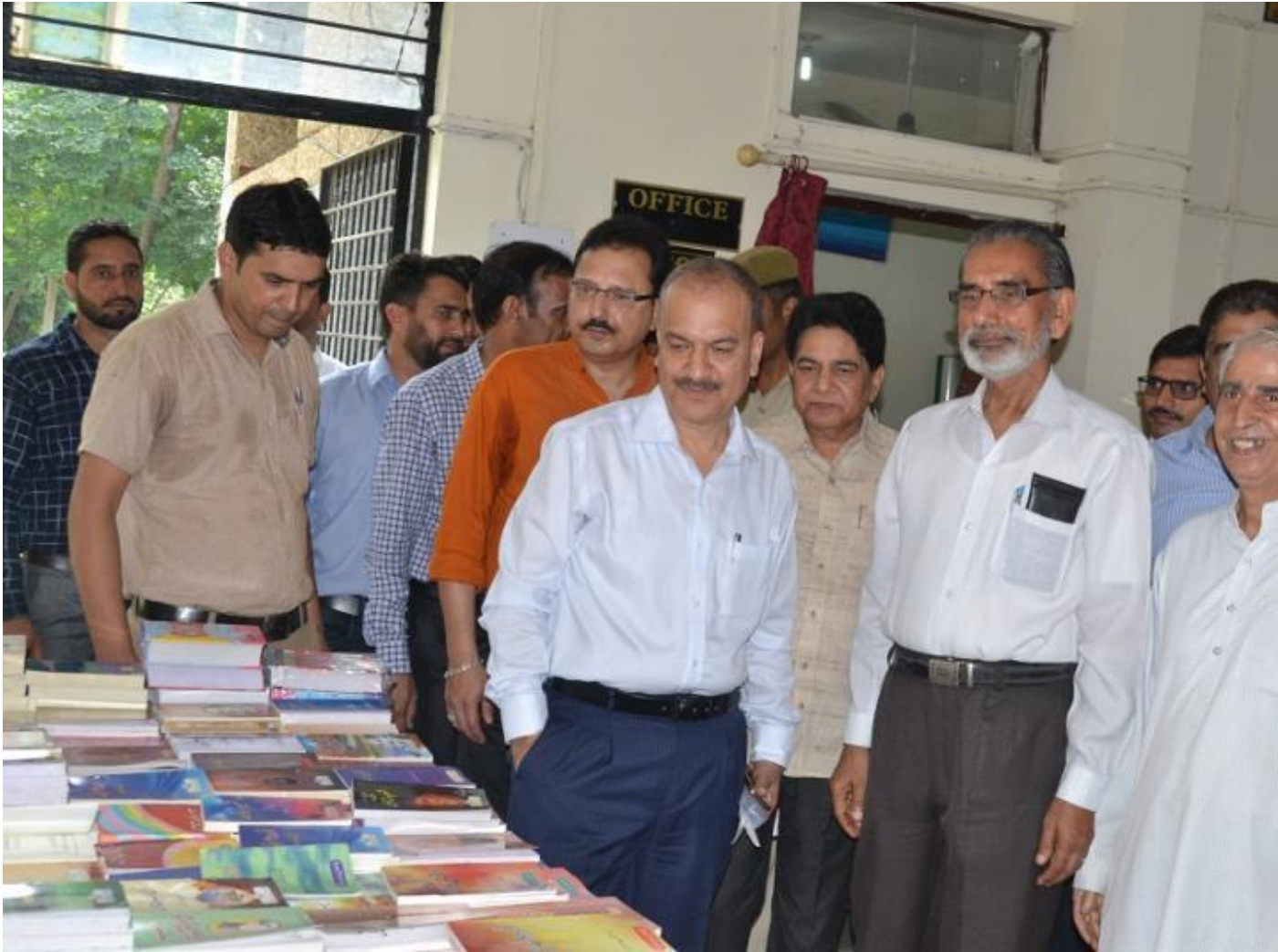

He was a fearless journalist, he uses his pen for the welfare of poor. Sheikh Ab Rehman also informed that Ved Bhasin was also associated with politics and fought an election from Jammu in 1976 and lose the election by only 26 votes. Ved Ji had great command on the techniques of Journalism. He never used yellow journalism but brought the truth on focus. He was last elder Journalist who had seen the partition of India and also was the witness of 1947 rites in Jammu. Ved Bhasin had good relation with many socialist leaders said Sheikh An Rehman. Earlier in his welcome address Prof. Shohab Inayat Malik HOD Urdu and President Rasa Javedani Memorial Literary Society Jammu presented a brief sketch of the life of Ved Bhasin. He informed that though Ved Bhasin was a student of Sanskrit and Hindi but he struggled for the welfare of Urdu language throughout his life.
