



Combretum indicum (L.) DeFilipps

Family: Combretaceae

Common name: Rangoon creeper

Importance:

- Used in expulsion of intestinal worms and has anticancerous properties.
- Leaf juice or seeds macerated in oil are applied externally to treat boils, ulcers, parasitic skin infections and fever.
- The bitter half-ripe fruits and seeds are anthelmintic and are used as such, usually as decoction, particularly to treat ascariasis.
