



Cycas circinalis L.

Family: Cycadaceae

Common name: Queen sago

Local name: Madanmast ka phool

Importance:

- The bark and the seeds are ground to a paste with oil and used as a poultice on sores and swellings.
- The juice of tender leaves is useful in the treatment of flatulence and vomiting.
- The leaves are used for plaiting into mats.
- The mature male cones are used as insect repellents in the paddy fields.
