FINAL MOP-UP COUNSELLING/ ADMISSION (OFFLINE MODE)

For Vacant Seats, all Categories Including Self Finance (ACADEMIC SESSION 2024-25)

It is for the information of all concerned that after the completion of FIVE ROUNDS of allocation of seats Final Mop-Up Round of Counselling / Admission for admission to the various PG Programmes of the University of Jammu/ Offsite Campuses & Affiliated Colleges, hereby notified as below:

1.	Commencement of FILLING of Fresh Online Admission FORM/ PREFERENCES on the University website with Fee of Rs.700/- (Seven Hundred Only)	23/07/2024 to 24/07/2024
2.	Online ACCEPTANCE of the applications by the Department/ Nodal Departments and various Committees (Reserved / Achievement)	23/07/2024 & 25/07/2024 (upto 04:00 pm)
3.	Reporting for Registration & Physical Verification of the Original Documents for OFFLINE COUNSELLING in the NODAL DEPARTMENTS of Main Campus of the University of Jammu	26-07-2024 (10:00 am to 01:00 PM)
4.	Admission in order of Merit/ Preferences for all categories including CUET Non-CUET & Self Finance	26-07-2024 (From 02:30 pm onwards)
5.	Dates for payment of ADMISSION FEE by the Candidates accepted for admission during Mop-Up Counselling	26-07-2024 to 27-07-2024 (Till 12:00 Midnight)
NOTE:		
1. After the Mop-Up Round. No further admissions to the PG Programmes of the University of Jammu shall be made for the Academic Session 2024-25.		
2. ADMISSION FEE of the provisionally admitted applicants in MOP-UP round shall be accepted by the Department / Nodal Departments through the OFFLINE MODE (Electronic/ Bank Transfer Only). Please ensure that no cash payment be entertained.		

IMPORTANT GUIDELINES FOR ADMISSIONS UNDER FINAL ALLOCATION & MOP-UP ROUND OF COUNSELLING:

1. Any applicant who failed to apply for PG Admission CSAS-PG-2024 (*Common Seat Allocation System-PG-2024*), within the stipulated time, and have passed the qualifying Bachelor's Degree Examination (Honours or General or a qualifying examination of a professional degree of not less than 3 years duration or any other examination recognised as equivalent thereof), from a recognised university/institution with at-least 50% of the aggregate marks (45% for the SC/ST candidates can apply for admission within stipulated time.
2. All the candidates, who have already filled online admission form and **Not Admitted** in any of the previous rounds **need not to apply afresh and shall also be considered for this round. However, these applicants have to OPT / FILL FRESH PREFERENCES for the vacant seats. Preferences given for the earlier allocation round shall become NULL & VOID.**
3. **All applicants, who apply or have applied earlier under NON-CUET, need to UPLOAD mark-sheets of all the semesters of the qualifying examination. Any applicant who fails to do so within specified time or fails to fulfil the basic eligibility of 50% of the aggregate marks (45% for the SC/ST candidates) in the qualifying examination, shall be rejected.**
4. **However, CUET applicants shall be considered for PROVISIONAL admission if they have passed the first 5 Semesters of the qualifying Bachelor's Degree Examination (Honours or General) (Only if 6th Sem. Result is awaited) / 6 Semesters of B.Tech, 8 Semester of LL.B (5 Yrs), 1 Semester of B.Lib.I.Sc (for M.Lib.) OR who has qualified examination of a professional degree of not less than 3 years duration OR any other examination recognised as equivalent thereof, from a recognised university/institution with at-least 50% of the aggregate marks (45% for the SC/ST candidates) as on date of allocation of seats**

5. The candidates, who have already been admitted in any of the programmes in the previous rounds of allocation, shall **not be eligible** for the Final / Mop-Up Round of Allocation/ Counselling.
6. **The CUET-PG-2024 applicants will be given first preference for admission and the Non-CUET applicants will be considered under second preference.**
7. CUET-PG-2024 applicants will be allocated seats on the basis of CUET-PG-2024 score whereas the Non-CUET applicants will be allocated seats on the basis of the academic merit of their qualifying examination.
8. **A candidate who applies in this Round will not hold any right to claim the seats allocated to candidates, who had applied to CSAS-PG-2024 during the previous rounds of allocation. Allocation of seats to such candidates may be considered subject to fulfillment of eligibility criteria, availability of seats, and other CSAS-PG-2024 rules.**
9. **It will be mandatory for the candidates to present in person in the Nodal Departments for Mop-Up Counselling/ Physical Verification of his/her original documents. Failure to do so will forfeit the candidate's right to seek admission to the programme.**
10. The provisional admission will only be confirmed after the successful remittance of the Admission Fee. Merely applying and appearing for Physical Verification/ Counselling does not confirm admission.
11. **In the Mop-Up Round, the admissions will be done on the basis of following Criteria.**
 - i) Availability of Seats in a particular Programme/ Campus
 - ii) Program Specific Merit
 - iii) Order of Preference of Deptts/ Campus/ College
 - iv) Category.
 - v) Any other allocation rules, policies or criteria mentioned in the notified guidelines on the admission website.
