
About the Seminar:

Layout of the Abstract and Full Paper:

Author(s): Provide Author's name, institution, email and contact details.

Abstract: Suitable title within 250-300 words, 3 to 5 keywords, problem specification, methodology and findings of the study.

• Note: Rename the MS-Word document of abstract by the name of the presenter/s.

Full Paper: Full paper should be written within 3000 word limit indicating problem of the study, review of related literature, objectives, methodology, findings of the study, educational implications, suggestions followed by references.

Text: Times New Roman with 12 Font size

Referencing Style: APA 6th Edition.
